My research focuses on the intersections of the following three topics. I list some of the research questions that fascinate me in these research domains.

Managerial Competencies and Executive Human and Social Capital:

- What makes managers and executive teams competent?
What defines managerial human and social capital and the levels of specificity at which they are developed or deployed?
- How does CEO succession affect the human and social capital profile of the senior executive team?
- How do the CEO's and the executives' human and social capital shape a firm's strategic path and dominant logic?
- How do firms cope globally with the managerial development challenges as they expand into new terrains?

Corporate Governance Effectiveness, Board Capital, and Ownership Structure:

- What constitutes effective board governance, individual director competence and board capital?
- What are key complementarities and trade-offs in CEO and board human and social capital combinations?
- How can firms manage the tensions between board independence and board competence?
- How does the firm's ownership structure impact the leadership choices, board governance, and value creation?
- How does the country context shape board structure, functioning, and effectiveness?

Resource Complementarities, Rigidities, and Strategic Renewal:

- In building a firm's set of competencies (internally or via acquisitions), what are key complementarities and toxic combinations of resource strategies and activities?
- What are the key path dependencies and dynamic adjustment costs that drive a firm's growth and strategic renewal?
- What are tensions and interactions among a firm's internal fit, external fit, and evolutionary fit?
- How does global competition shape a firm's ability and efforts in strategic renewal?

I enjoy doing research on both large corporations and entrepreneurial firms operating in the U.S. and global markets. I have done industry-focused research on firms in medical devices industry, biotechnology industry, professional service firms (law firms), food and beverage industry (conventional and organic food), railroad industry, and international social ventures.
